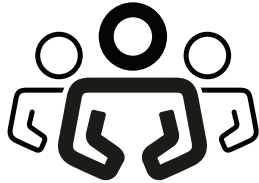

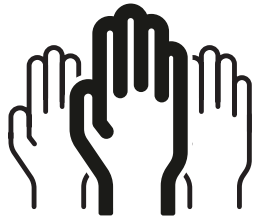
WHO WE ARE

- A world in which human rights abusers are held accountable.

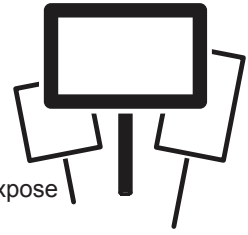


WHAT WE DO

- We're more than 8 million people from all walks of life, from over 150 countries standing together to challenge injustice and change the world

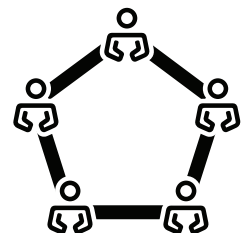


JUST SOME OF WHAT WE HAVE ACHIEVED

- **Prisoners of conscience:** The solidarity of our members uniting for justice and freedom has achieved the release of thousands of political prisoners across the globe.
- **Arms Trade Treaty:** After 20 years of focused effort, the multilateral agreement that regulates the international trade in conventional weapons came into force in 2014.
- **Death penalty:** When we started in 1961, only 9 countries had abolished state executions. Now 142 countries have stopped using the death penalty.
- **Stop torture:** We have helped survivors of torture be released from prison and sparked investigations into allegations of torture.
- **Women's rights:** The solidarity of our members across the globe has helped advocate for women and girls to enjoy their sexual and reproductive rights without discrimination or coercion, and live free from gender-based violence.
