

AUSTRALIA: FIGHTING TO SAVE THEIR ANCESTRAL LANDS

Uncle Pabai (he/him) and Uncle Paul's (he/him) ancestors have lived on islands of the Torres Strait for thousands of years. Now their whole way of life – which as Indigenous Peoples is deeply connected to land, sea and sky – is at risk because of climate change. If the islands become uninhabitable, they will be forced to break these connections and leave their homelands.

To protect the Torres Strait Islands and the human rights of First Nations Peoples, I call on your government to take adequate and human rights-consistent climate action by rapidly reducing carbon emissions in line with the world commitment of limiting global warming to 1.5°C and in line with the best available scientific research.
