

RUSSIA: FREE ACTIVIST MARK KISLITSYN

Mark is a transgender man and human-rights defender from Moscow - he had been outspoken against the full-scale invasion of Ukraine and consistently advocated for equality and LGBTI+ rights. For that, he's now imprisoned over 3,000 kilometres from his home in Moscow, in a women's penal colony, where he's forced to wear women's clothing, denied gender-affirming medical treatment, and frequently thrown into solitary confinement on fabricated grounds. Mark's courage and compassion represents the very best of humanity, yet the Russian authorities have branded him a traitor for standing up for peace. His imprisonment exposes the growing repression in Russia, where laws targeting LGBTI+ people and anti-war voices have created a climate of fear and violence. No one should face prison for defending human rights, expressing solidarity, or being themselves. Call on the Russian government to immediately and unconditionally release Mark Kislitsyn, ensure his safety and medical care while in detention, and uphold the right to freedom of expression for all.
